The below are key points to be considered in our new Academic Year.

#### A. Textbook

The newly introduced set of study resources in 2021, which was indeed the product of a year's tremendous effort from our teachers across this region has been widely accepted by students, teachers and parents. It is our duty to wisely utilize these new study resources for the spiritual nurturing of our children and to raise them in strong Orthodox faith and Biblical knowledge. The textbooks will be delivered on or before 06<sup>th</sup> February 2022. The invoice will be sent and the payment should be done to the account details shared (directly to the printing press this year).

### **B.** Examination/Assessment

All Sunday schools should conduct two examinations every year – Half yearly examination and Annual Examination. The dates and scheduling details will be shared via another circular on a later date.

- 3. Years 4 & 5 --- Written examinations
  - a) One-word answers 20%
  - b) Match the following 20%
  - c) True or False 10%
  - d) Answer in one or two sentences 30%
  - e) Prayer & hymns 20%
- 4. Years 6 & 7 --- Written examinations
  - a) One sentence answer 20%
  - b) Match the following 10%
  - c) Short answers 40%
  - d) Prayer & hymns 30%
- 5. Years 8, 9 & 11 --- Written examinations
  - a) One sentence answer 20%
  - b) Short paragraph answers 40%
  - c) Essay answers 20%
  - d) Prayer & hymns 20%

- 7. Final examination scores for Years 1 to 9 calculated as follows:

50% (Midyear marks), 50% (Final exam marks),

- 8. Portions for Midyear & Final exams will be Part 1 & 2 respectively from the Text Book.
- 9. Additional Prayer & Hymns will be advised separately for each class term wise.
- 10. All students must appear for both the examinations to qualify for promotion to the next class.
- 11. Re-exam for Years 1 to 9 and 11 be conducted by the individual Sunday Schools for children who have missed exams on original date.
- 12. Question Papers for Years 10 & 12 will be set and valued centrally.
- 13. For Years 10 and 12, a minimum of 35% marks are required for passing the exam
- 14. Re exam for Class 10 & 12 be conducted 2 weeks after the declaration of results.
